Why not adapt the literature review of your thesis, or turn that assignment you have slaved over into an entry, and give yourself a chance at winning \$300 and of having a publication and prize to add to your CV? Finalists' essays may also be published in the AMOS Bulletin.

Entries should be supplied via email as a pdf or in a format readable by Open Office, and accompanied by details of the entrant's contact address and his or her university enrolment and a declaration that the essay is the student's own work.
